Caloundra Juniors Australian Football Club (CJAFC) commits to a strong focus on community and continues to work hard with its players, coaches and members alike, in order to both promote and build on the values of the club.

CJAFC is currently home to more than 200 junior players, in age groups from U6 to U17.

As the designated AFL Club for the Caloundra South corridor, CJAFC's player and supporter base is continuing to increase as more young people join the club to play AFL.

The club has enthusiastically embraced the addition of U13, U15 and U17 girl's AFL teams, with more young girls drawing encouragement from the burgeoning growth of the AFLW league to pursue their own AFL journey. 2023 continued to be another noticeable growth season for our CJAFC female teams with player number increases and several of our girls being selected into the Brisbane Lions Academy Program.

The growth of this offering at CJAFC means that junior female players have a clear pathway to continue their AFL path, with players encouraged to progress through to the women's QAFW senior side.

2022 was an exciting inaugural year for CJAFC's senior female players as they competed as part of the Caloundra Panthers family for the first time, with the junior female team competing for their second season.

A successful 2023 season was had by our senior women's team, achieving Runners-Up in the QFA Hart Div. 3 competition.

Our senior men's teams also showed success on the field with Seniors and Reserves both finishing top 4 in the QFA Hart Div. 1 competition, our QFA Hart Div. 4 side took home the premiership.

Carter Park on North Street, Golden Beach is home ground for the Caloundra Panthers, but also forms part of the 'Caloundra Reserve1000 Sports Hub' - a highly frequented sports venue used for AFL, Little Athletics, Netball, Basketball, Volleyball, and numerous other sports that frequent the neighbouring stadium and amenities.

The CJAFC has a strong community focus and includes regular 'additional' activations in the overall club program, such as special events, training sessions and other community engagement programs.

This extended reach into the community offers sponsors the opportunity for wider brand recognition, potential engagement with a larger audience and extended public reach.
